Decide

First you have an idea --

Discuss

- We will answer any questions you might have.
- Discuss timing and logistics.
- Finally, we will provide you a proposal based on your request.

Finalize

When you are ready --

- Together we will agree on costs and mutual responsibilities for the training.
- A contract will be prepared.
- Dates will be scheduled.
- Address any other needs you requested.
